In 2016, the Aerospace industry achieved a record output of S\$8.98 billion. The Aerospace industry employs close to 21,500 workers, of which 90% are skilled.</p> <p>Leading players such as SIA Engineering Company and ST Aerospace carry out comprehensive nose-to-tail MRO services from airframe maintenance to engine overhaul to aircraft modifications and conversion. Aside from MRO, Singapore is also seeing a growing number of Aerospace design and manufacturing operations, with leading engine manufacturers such as Rolls Royce having a manufacturing presence here.</p>

Programme Overview :	The Professional Conversion Programme (PCP) for Aerospace Officer and Aerospace Executive integrates job-matching and reskilling to help PMET jobseekers gain new skills and prepare

	<p>them for new job roles in fleet planning, quality assurance, technical servicing, workshop engineering and cabin retrofitting works.</p> <p>The PCP is administered by SIA Engineering Company (SIAEC) and Temasek Polytechnic (TP). Through a Place-and-Train mode, participating companies will employ the trainees before they embark on rigorous training comprising facilitated / classroom training, and structured On-the-Job-Training (OJT).</p> <p>Programme Support for Companies This PCP aims to help lower the companies' cost of hiring PMETs by providing salary support at 70% of participant's salary capped at \$4,000 per month for the duration of training. Enhanced salary support of 90% of participant's salary capped at \$6,000 per month will be applicable for Singapore Citizens (SC) who has been unemployed for more than 6 months, or mature SC PMETs that are aged 40 and above.</p> <p>In addition to salary support, participating companies would also receive course fee support of up to 90% to help lower the fees incurred.</p>
